On this 76th Foundation Day Celebration of Ramananda College, we jovially greet each and every one who is present here to partake in this propitious event. We offer our best wishes to all the teachers, non-teaching staff members, hostel employees, students, research scholars, counsellors, alumnae and all other dignitaries.

We observe this day to rejuvenate our thoughts relating to the diversified fields of education. In this auspicious day, we also make our mind to promote education for our learners and the society at large as we think that education is the best means of ensuring social justice, national integrity and communal harmony.

The academic year of 2019-2020 was of great significance to this educational institution as during this year the college has gone through its Platinum Jubilee. The institution has just completed 75 years of its responsibility as a sentinel of higher education in the Bishnupur sub-division of Bankura district. This great institution is carrying 75 years of heritage with it through embracing the past, celebrating the present and building the future.

To make this occasion memorable to everyone, a yearlong celebration of the platinum jubilee was framed by us. Originally it was proposed that the yearlong celebration would be split into three phases throughout the year and eventually would come to an end on the 76th Foundation day of Ramananda College on 01.07.2020. As per our plan, the first phase of yearlong celebration of the Platinum Jubilee of Ramananda College was started on 01. 07. 2019 (on the 75th foundation day) with apposite pomp and splendour. However due to the outburst of COVID-19 pandemic throughout the world, we couldn't arrange the second phase of the celebration as per our plan and also today we are forced to postponed the closing ceremony which will be held later on.

This year has witnessed drastic changes in educational system owing to sudden outburst of COVID-19 pandemic. The educational reform in India in the COVID-19 era seems to be a live example of how need truly is the mother of invention or reinvention, in this scenario. Allowing educational institutions to adopt online learning and infuse a virtual study culture, the pandemic is already steering the sector forward with technological innovation and advancements. The switch to online education has been ensuring that students suffer no loss of studies and their progress is being tracked simultaneously with timely evaluation. It is probably the first time for India to experiment with the education system and make a paradigm shift to the virtual world, blending classrooms with online learning.

Marching along with the rest of the country, our institution is not lagging behind to take on the new system of online education. College authority has introduced an online platform for teaching-learning activity. Our faculty members utilized various online platforms to communicate with the students to their utmost satisfaction and completed syllabi in time. The IQAC of this institution has created online library of e-contents and model questions for students and faculties.

Short history of Ramananda College:

Ramananda College is a pioneering higher-educational institution located at Bishnupur, within the district of Bankura. It is the sole co-educational Degree College with PG courses recognized by the UGC within Bishnupur town. Since its inception in 1945, this institution has been serving the cause of higher education in the local community and also of students from far-away, remote villages. Even today students from other districts are studying here.

Sri Ramnalini Chakraborty, freedom-fighter and social worker of Bishnupur, Sri Radhagobinda Roy, founder-principal of this college and ex-minister, Govt. of West Bengal and other eminent community members of Bishnupur decided to establish this college here. Sri Ramnalini Chakraborty, the Koley family, Sri Anil Kumar Bhattacharya, members of the Friends' Union Club and the community maximally funded the costs for building this college. The college is named after

the son of the soil, Sri Ramananda Chattopadhyay (1865-1943), journalist, editor and scholar who was active during the Bengal Renaissance.

Initially the college was affiliated to the University of Calcutta, later to the University of Burdwan and now under the affiliation of the Bankura University since 1st January, 2017. The college is recognized by the UGC under Sections 2F and 12B. As the college was established before Independence, it predates both the creations of the UGC and the University of Burdwan. In 2015, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) re-accredited (2nd cycle as B) the College with 2.75 score. Further, with the introduction of different Post Graduate Courses in Science and Humanities, the college has become a constituent college of the Bankura University. Now the college is compliant with the visions of RUSA.

There is an IGNOU special study centre within the campus of Ramananda College. Prof. Ajit Debnath is working as the Coordinator of the study centre. The centre offers 14 professional and job-oriented courses. The study centre has 17 approved academic Counsellors. The academic Counsellors are actively engaged in the process of evaluation of assignments and counselling session of the learners. The number of newly registered and re-
